 - 5. What are your scholastic and career goals?
 - 6. How did you finance your freshman year and how will you finance your sophomore year?
 - 7. Why are you a good candidate to receive this scholarship?
 - 8. What have you learned about Dr. Hartig, how does he influence or inspire you, and how will you preserve his legacy as recipient of this scholarship?
