

Housing Application

Students going into housing, must submit an application online through eRezLife. **Starting March 3.**

Room and Board Contracts are binding for the full academic year.

Reminder of UE's 3-year residency requirement.

This process is only for those on campus for fall 2025.





- •Once logged into eRezLife, select Apply for Housing under the Recommended Actions section on your homepage.
- •Follow the on-screen instructions on the next several pages.
- •Be sure to accept the terms of the contract. Your application is not complete unless you accept the terms of the contract.

Next step after housing application is submitted, click the link to pay \$75 non-refundable housing registration fee.

To receive a room selection appointment and have your room confirmed, you need have submitted your housing registration fee.



Form your roommate group using Roomeez.

Specific Roommates

- Form a roommate group
- Select "Roommate Groups"
- Chosen roommates need to have a completed application and accept your invitation.
- Only if you do not know their UE email.

Find Roommates

- Turn on your Roomeez profile.
- Decide what information you want to share.
- Search for possible roommates and send messages.
- Invite to your roommate group.





Select your housing (at your assigned selection time).

Students must have submitted all required materials to be assigned housing. Required materials include a completed application and housing registration fee.

Any spaces assigned during the housing process are subject to adjustment or reassignment by the Office of Residence Life if necessary.

Your start term at the university will be taken into consideration as well when you submitted your housing application when making room selection appointments.

How To Apply For Housing And Create Roommate Group

This guide provides a step-by-step process for applying for housing and forming a roommate group at the University of Evansville. A \$75 non-refundable housing registration fee is due after you submit your application. You will not receive a housing selection appointment if you do not pay the housing registration fee.



Housing Assignment Calendar – Returning Students

- March 3 March 21
 - Apply for housing in eRezLife.
 - Submit your \$75 non-refundable housing registration fee in your eRezLife account.
- March 3 March 24
 - Form roommate groups in eRezLife (roommates will need to have a completed application and accept your roommate group invitation).
 - View available rooms and save preferences before your selection application after you receive selection appointment time.
- March 24 April 4
 - Room selection appointments by assigned times.



Wait Lists

- If you do not get a placement you desire, you can select to be placed on a wait list. Wait lists are used throughout the summer.
- •Any spaces reclaimed or chosen during the housing process are subject to adjustment or reassignment by the Office of Residence Life if necessary.



Single Rooms

\$1,000 more per semester.

Single rooms are standard double rooms.

All furniture remains in the rooms.

If interested in a single room, indicate on your housing application AND email Residence Life by March 21.



Meal Plans

After you select your room, you will be able to select your meal plan in your eRezLife account.

Cancelation Policy

May 1st Deadline – Any Reason (seniors)

After May 1st, you can ONLY cancel housing for the following reasons:

- Going to Harlaxton or Study Abroad
- Living locally with parents / legal guardians
- Interning / Clinical / Co-op / Student Teaching outside of Evansville area (full time)
- Transferring, graduating, or withdrawing
