EFD HIRING PROCESS

Applicants then must successfully complete the EFD Fire Merit Board examination process and the Indiana Public Employee Retirement Fund (PERF) physical and mental health examinations.

Requirements for Application:

- · U.S. Citizenship
- High School Diploma or equivalent
- · 21 when the list is certified to 39 years of age (must be employed by EFD before 40)
- Valid driver license
- · No felony convictions
- · Good moral character

Fire Merit Board Examination Process:

- · Pass Written Test
- · Take Oral Examination
- · Pass Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT)

Indiana Public Employee Retirement Fund (PERF) Examination Process:

- · Pass Medical Physical Examination
- · Pass Psychological Evaluation
